## Robert S. Darbee Awards Chair – 2014 Newport Bermuda Race





Up to four prizes may be awarded per class based on the number of starting vessels as follows: First (1-3), Second (4-7), Third (8-11), Fourth (12+). Similarly for the William L. Glenn Family Participation Prize.

Prize scoring is based on ORR unless otherwise noted. Additionally, under IRC scoring, there will be  $1^{st}$  place awards (only) in each St. David's and Gibbs Hill class.

Certain prizes marked "X-DV" are for "Best Performance" scored cross-divisionally by comparing across divisions the decimal percentage ORR corrected time placing of vessels within their respective divisions.

Eastern Ocean Racing Championship Prize – "X-DV" scoring applied to the entire fleet for this NBR (ORR) and prevailing handicap system(s) for Annapolis-Newport. Championship Prize goes to the vessel with lowest combined score among vessels competing in both races.

"Special Entry" is required for: Pratt 3-Boat Team Prize, Regional Prizes and Glenn Family Participation Prize. Special Entry forms available at bermudarace.com. All three are scored cross-divisionally (X-DV).
