## Robert S. Darbee Awards Chair – 2020 Newport Bermuda Race

Up to four prizes may be awarded per class based on the number of starting vessels as follows:

First (1-3), Second (4-7), Third (8-11), Fourth (12+). Similarly for the William L. Glenn Family Participation Prize.

Prize scoring is based on ORR unless otherwise noted.

Certain prizes marked “X-DV” are for “Best Performance” scored cross-divisionally by comparing across divisions the decimal percentage ORR corrected time placing of vessels within their respective divisions.

Eastern Ocean Racing Championship Prize – “X-DV” applied to the entire fleet for this NBR (ORR) and prevailing handicap system(s) for Annapolis-Newport. Championship Prize goes to the vessel with lowest combined score among vessels competing in both races.

“**Special Entry**” is required for: 1) Pratt 3-Boat Team Prize, 2) Regional Prizes, 3) City of Newport (Best Performance by a “Foreign” Yacht) and 4) Glenn Family Participation Prize. Special Entry forms available at bermudarace.com. All four are scored cross-divisionally (X-DV). Special Entry is, in part, so that skippers are not sidetracked in gathering this information at time of vessel entry. On occasion some NBR entrants, with what ultimately proved to be outstanding performances, have overlooked coming back to “Special Entry” when their requisite information had become available and missed out on prizes they otherwise would have won. Do not let this be you!

**EVERY SDL, GHL, DH, FI yacht in the 2020 Newport Bermuda Race should be a member of a 3-boat Pratt Team. Each winning vessel receives a plaque with its own lines as provided by US Sailing. Requires Special Entry.**

**EVERY yacht with at least 4 family members aboard should look to qualify for the William L Glenn Family Participation Prize (double-check “Family” criteria on entry form). Requires Special Entry.**

Entries for Pratt Teams, Glenn Family Participation, City of Newport and Regional Prizes are accepted up until 0900hrs. Friday, June 19 via **Special Entry forms at bermudarace.com**

**Prizegiving will be at Government House Saturday, June 27, 1800 hours and is by invitation only. Each yacht will receive 2 pair of invitations, additional will be provided to prize-winning vessels.**
