Up to four prizes may be awarded per class based on the number of starting vessels as follows:

First (1-3), Second (4-7), Third (8-11), Fourth (12+). Similarly for the William L. Glenn Family Participation Prize.

Prize scoring based on ORR unless otherwise noted.

Certain prizes marked “X-DV” are for “Best Performance” scored cross-divisionally by comparing across subject divisions the decimal percentage ORR corrected time placing of vessels within their respective divisions.

Eastern Ocean Racing Championship Prize – “X-DV” applied to entire fleet for this NBR (ORR) & prevailing handicap system(s) for most recent Annapolis-Newport. Championship to the vessel with lowest combined score among vessels competing in both races.

“**Special Entry**” is required for: 1) Pratt 3-Boat Team Prize, 2) Regional Prizes, 3) City of Newport (Best Performance by a “Foreign” Yacht), 4) Glenn Family Participation Prize 5) Stephens Brothers Youth Division (And, CCA Member 2-boat teams.) Special Entry forms available at: <https://bermudarace.com/prizes/#special-awards>. All five are scored cross-divisionally (X-DV). Special Entry is, in part, so that skippers are not sidetracked in gathering this information at time of vessel entry. On occasion some NBR entrants, with what ultimately proved to be outstanding performances, have overlooked coming back to “Special Entry” when their requisite information had become available and missed out on prizes they otherwise would have won. **Do not let this be you!**

**EVERY SDL, GHL, DH, FI yacht in the 2024 Newport Bermuda Race should be a member of a 3-boat Pratt Team! Each winning vessel receives a plaque with its own lines as provided by US Sailing. Requires Special Entry.**

**EVERY yacht with at least 4 family members aboard should look to qualify for the William L Glenn Family Participation Prize (double-check “Family” criteria on entry form). Requires Special Entry.**

“Special Entry” for Pratt Teams, Glenn Family Participation, City of Newport, Youth Division and Regional Prizes accepted up until **0900 hrs. Friday, June 21.** (Ditto, CCA Member 2-boat teams.)

\* The St. David’s Lighthouse Trophy was first awarded in 1954 and has become the Race trademark. The next 3 such awards – 1956, 1958, 1960 – were all won by Carleton Mitchell and his 38’ S&S yawl *Finisterre*. In the 118-year history of this Race, no other skipper/vessel pairing has matched this back-to-back-to back “hat trick”.
